

Winchester Lady Cup Rules and Calculations Process

A season-long, sporting clays competition designed specifically for ladies who shoot on the NSCA Championship Tour, powered by Winchester. The Winchester Ladies Cup will span the NSCA Championship Tour events each year.

At each tour stop \$6,750 in added payout dollars will be awarded to the top five lady competitors in the Main event. The Lady Champion will receive an additional \$3,000, runner-up will receive \$1,500, third place will receive \$1,000, fourth place \$750, and fifth place will receive \$500. The Winchester added payouts total \$47,250 for the tour each year.

At the end of the season, the coveted Winchester Ladies Cup trophy will be awarded to the top Lady competitor with the highest cumulative placement for the entire season.

Winchester Lady Cup Tour Points Race Calculations:

1. All NSCA Lady concurrent members are eligible, including international members. There is no minimum event participation required for the points race, but to be eligible to win the Overall Winchester Lady Cup Trophy you must participate in the Main Event at either the National Championship or U.S. Open.

2. The top 10 ladies within the Main Event at each of the Championship Tour events will be awarded points.

3. Example of Points Distribution and Ranking of Tied Scores:

174 = 10

173 = 9

171 = 8

171 = 8 (7 skipped due to tie)

171 = 8 (6 skipped due to tie)

169 = 5

163 = 4

163 = 4 (3 skipped due to tie)

161 = 2

160 = 1

Notice that tied scores are given the same number of points, but the next lower number is skipped so that only 10 points are distributed.

4. The top 5 scores from the Championship Tour are added together for a Top 5 Grand Total. Thereby a max of 50 points could be awarded to a competitor.

5. In the case of ties for crowning a Lady Cup Tour Champion, the Main Event score at the National Championship will be used to break the tie, then if still tied the US Open score will be used.
