Section 8 in the binder - There was no new business. Presentations for the site of the 2018 US Open were given. Randy Voss gave the presentation for Caribou Gun Club in MN. Tim Miles gave the presentation for Coyote Spring in AZ and Scott Robertson gave the presentation for Side X Side Ranch in OK. Brett Seibert called for the secret vote of the 2018 US Open site; all ballots were collected and counted aloud by the Executive Council. Of the 45 Advisory Council members, there were a total of 40 votes taken, with 3 abstaining (Randy Voss, Tim Miles and Scott Robertson) and 2 absent members (Dan Twitchell and Anthony Matarese, SR). The vote tally was as follows: Caribou Gun Club – 13 votes, Coyote Springs – 15 votes and Side X Side Ranch – 12 votes. The site of the 2018 US Open will be Coyote Spring in Tucson, AZ.
