OPENING CEREMONY

When: Friday, April 28 Where: Shoot-Off Stadium Time: Approximately 6:30 PM

Teams and individual shooters representing foreign countries will be introduced along with the USA Sporting Clays Team Friday evening.

CLOSING CEREMONY

When: Sunday, April 30 Where: Shoot-Off Stadium

Time: Immediately following shoot-offs.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: This is an International Event open to all Countries. NSCA membership is required for all competitors. Citizens of the U.S. are also requested to provide their Social Security number at the time of entry so that checks may be sent more quickly. A shooter's eligibility for concurrent events, which are based on age, is determined by the age of the shooter on January 1 of the shooting year. No contestant shall be eligible for more than one individual concurrent event based on age.

Sub-Junior - Any person who had not reached their 16th birthday by January 1, 2017 Junior - Any person who had not reached their 21st birthday by January 1, 2017 Veteran - Any person 55 years of age as of January 1, 2017 who had not reached

their 65th birthday as of January 1, 2017

Super Veteran - Any person 65 years of age and over who has not yet reached their 75th birthday by January 1, 2017

Senior Super Veteran - Any Person 75 years of age and over by January 1, 2017

RULES & REGULATIONS: All NSCA and/or FITASC Rules apply. All Management decisions are final. By entering the competition, every person agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by NSCA and/or FITASC Rules. Shooters are strongly encouraged to familiarize themselves with NSCA Rules and abide by them, for both their own benefit and the benefit of other shooters.

*Main event entry will close at 1pm

DAILY FEE: 5¢ per target on all registered targets. (4¢ to NSCA, 1¢ to TSCA)

MAINTENANCE FEE: 2¢ per target on all registered targets. These specially designated monies will be used for maintenance and/or improvements on our home ground facilities.

ENTRY REFUNDS: After March 15, there will be no entry refunds unless the event is cancelled. Shoot Management will consider emergency medical withdrawals accompanied by a written request. No refunds due to weather.

SHOOT-OFFS: All shoot-offs will be held at the conclusion of Sunday's events.

All ties in the Preliminary Event, 20 & 28 Gauge FITASC, Adios Cup, NSCA 5-Stand, Small Gauge Events, Super Sporting and Parcours de Chasse (FITASC) Events for Open Champion, Runner-Up, Third, Class First and Concurrent First will be shot off Sunday evening at the conclusion of all events. Ties for other places will be decided by total score on predetermined stations.

All ties in the World English Sporting Clay Championship Main Event for Open, Class and Concurrent Champion, Runner-Up and Third will be shot-off Sunday evening at the conclusion of all events. Ties for other places will be decided by total score on predetermined stations. The top 6 shooters and all ties will advance to a 25-bird shoot-off Sunday evening in Shoot-Off Stadium. All awards for the top 6 shooters and guaranteed money for Champion, Runner-Up and Third will be based on 225 targets (200 Main Event targets plus 25 targets in the shoot-off of the top 6 shooters).

PRACTICE COURSE & PRACTICE 5-STAND FIELDS: A 10-station practice course will be available Monday thru Sunday. Practice course keys are available in the Pro Shop of the Club House Monday 9 AM - 6PM and Tuesday – Sunday 7 AM - 6 PM. Practice 5-Stand tickets may be purchased in the Ammo Building and Pro-Shop inside the Club House. Practice 5-Stand is available on West Vendors Row Wednesday – Saturday 7 AM - 5 PM and Sunday 7 AM - 2 PM.

Ammunition: Available at various prices for different loads will be all major brands of factory ammunition. Prices and loads will be posted at the ammunition building. No reloads allowed in any event or game of this tournament. No 3" loads allowed. Maximum loads for any event (including games):

Soliciting, Sales & Distribution: No soliciting, distribution of literature of any kind, sales or distribution of shot shells or any other type of merchandise is allowed on the grounds without the express written permission of management. The NSCA reserves the right to the name and logo of the 2017 World English Sporting Clay Championship. Any paraphernalia not approved by the NSCA is prohibited on the grounds.

Campsites: Camper space for this event is \$175 for the tournament (first come, first serve). Opens Sunday, April 23 at noon. Shower houses and restrooms are available 24 hours. All spaces have water supply and electrical hookup (capacity is 50 AMP or 30 AMP, 110 volt). Reservations must be made with Olivia at the National Shooting Complex; phone-210-688-3371 ext. 138, email- nscrv@nssa-nsca.com. We will do everything possible to accommodate groups who wish to be assigned adjoining spaces. All campers must sign in upon arrival.

Exhibit Space: Exhibit space is available. Fee is \$175 for a 25' x 35' outdoor space. A 6' table with two chairs in Mini Mall is \$225. Advance reservations must be made with Olivia at the NSC; email- nscrv@nssa-nsca.com, phone- 210-688-3371 ext. 138.

Protests & Corrections: It is the shooter's responsibility to see that he/she is placed in the correct class upon entering this event. Any shooter in the wrong class will be disqualified.

Corrections to scores, event and concurrent entries should be reported to Registration as soon as they are noticed. It is very important for shooters to check the scoreboard to make certain they have been entered in all events for which they are qualified as no additions or corrections to concurrent entries will be made after noon Saturday, April 29. Shooters are urged to check their scores each day as corrections to awards will not be made unless Registration is notified prior to shoot-offs beginning or, in the case of awards not involved in ties, before 6 pm April 30.

Protests must be submitted in writing to Shoot Management by 6 pm (or 15 minutes after last shot fired) the day the event is shot. Exception: Shooters needing to file a protest on an occurrence that happened on the last flight Friday, Saturday or Sunday must immediately report to Shoot Management for instructions. All protests must be made in accordance with NSCA or FITASC rules and will be decided upon by the Protest Committee whose decision is final.

Personal Cart Insurance: NSSA-NSCA-NSC has implemented a policy that proof of liability insurance is required for operation of personally-owned carts at the facility. Minimum liability, such as written for auto policies, for injury/accident is what is required. The policy is required to have reference to the cart that is to be operated and often can be added to current auto or home owner policies. Proof of insurance can be sent prior to your arrival via email to Lori Hartmann at Ihartmann@nssa-nsca.com or by US Mail to:

If you are unable to send insurance in advance of arrival, simply bring your proof of insurance into Registration when you arrive and a permit will be produced and issued.

Clays Cars: Individually-owned clays cars, gators, mules and other similar vehicles are allowed or, if you prefer, clays cars may be rented. No ATV or 4-wheelers allowed. You must be at least 18 years old to operate a clays car. Special rules apply and permits are required for both personal and rental carts. Personal cart forms can be downloaded from www.mynsca.com. A \$10 trail fee is required for all personal carts. A cart permit will be issued upon NSCA receiving the trail fee and verifying insurance. Safety Requirements: Eye and ear protection is mandatory. All persons, spectators, shooters, referees and trap personnel must wear eye and ear protection on the course.

Shotgun Storage: Secure storage is available for participants' guns. Cost is \$5 per day per gun.

Inclement Weather/Lightning Plan Of Action: At the first sign of an approaching storm, local Doppler radar will be monitored for the direction and severity of the storm. At the same time, shoot management will be strategically positioned to monitor the approaching storm for lightning and any other potential dangerous elements.

At first sight of lightning (by and/or relayed to any shoot staff), a cease-fire will be called immediately via PA system and by shoot management to each field where PA is not available. All fields will be cleared of both participants and staff, with all taking cover in available areas, i.e.: Club House, Vendor Buildings, vehicles, etc.

Shoot management will continue to monitor lightning strikes, starting a new time clock with each observed strike. At the duration of 20 minutes with no strikes, shoot management will begin the process of returning participants to the field(s) to continue with shooting. By starting this process at 20 minutes, the total elapsed time from the last strike until shooting begins is anticipated to be 30 or more minutes.

The above process will be repeated for any and all storms/lightning strikes observed.

In the event of any other dangerous elements of an approaching storm, such as extremely high winds/tornado or hail, the same cease-fire and field evacuation procedures as above will be implemented as soon as the danger is realized.

Other Information: Shoot Management reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program if conditions warrant. Management decisions are final. In accordance with NSCA Rules, Shoot Management may refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot or, in Management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike.

Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the NSC property. The NSC and NSCA are not responsible for theft or accidents of personal property or vehicles.






