NSCA COLLEGIATE SCHOLARSHIP

National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) offers an established Scholarship Program each year to a deserving applicant. This NSCA Scholarship is based on a 4-year degree program and will present a \$2,500 scholarship to 4 eligible high school seniors each year.

It is the responsibility of the recipient to send a copy of each semester's grades bearing the seal of the office of the Registrar to NSCA Headquarters (grades from the internet will not be accepted). Scholarship payment will be made at the end of each semester after grades have been submitted. Summer sessions are excluded from this program. Full-time status (12 hrs. minimum per semester) and a "B" average (3.0 GPA or greater) must be maintained to continue this scholarship. A reasonable lapse in attendance for college approved internship program may be permitted. Continued active NSCA registered sporting clays participation is required.

This application will be for 2018 beginning with the 2018 Fall semester. We expect applicants to be active NSCA participants; however, selection will be based on a combination of scholarship, citizenship and participation in NSCA activities.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be an NSCA member.
- 2. Must be a 2018 high school graduate.
- 3. Completion of Scholarship Application (enclosed with application).
- 4. Essay (250 words or less) describing your goals and reasons why you should be awarded this scholarship.
- 5. A letter of personal recommendation (i.e., High School Counselor, Sporting Clays Instructor, etc.)
- 6. Copy of class rank/high school grades from your school registrar.
- 7. Copy of past shooting history and accomplishments.

SCTP Tour Events

During 2017 we held seven SCTP Tour Events across the country. Some were discipline specific while two consisted of both skeet and sporting clays. While attendance could have been better at each event, I believe all were successful in their own way. Some of the events exposed competitive shooting to youth shooters for the first time while others revealed the friendships and camaraderie that shooting sports can create. This program will continue for 2018 and we had some clubs very interested in hosting in 2018. I have included a flyer with a list of all the events confirmed for 2018. I have a request for another sporting clays shoot in Texas which I am working on.

SCTP All American Team

The new SCTP All American Team seems to have had a successful first year. We had approximately 400 shooters who shot at least one major SCTP event who shot a minimum of 500 NSSA or NSCA registered targets. As Headquarters along with SCTP continue to promote this program it should continue to grow and be a successful program for us to recognize more young shooters' achievements. In order to track the teams our IT department created a new page under the respective recognition tabs of our website for shooters to track their standings. I have been contacted by many parents and coaches seeking information on the program who are excited about the potential recognition. In the coming weeks, after the NSSA and NSCA All-American Teams are selected we will be able to announce the SCTP All-American Teams. We will send them a patch and certificate as we do for all of our All-American selections. For those interested in viewing the pages the respective websites are listed below.

Youth Camps

We had a number of successful NSSA youth camps in 2017 and clubs are already contacting us to prepare for 2018. As we all know, Ralph Aaron will be stepping down this year from leading the Youth Camp Program and the administrative side is currently being done from Headquarters by myself. We are looking to create and publish all the criteria and information regarding youth camps and will continue to promote this program as it is a great way to introduce new youth shooters to shooting.

Youth Shoot Reimbursement Program

In 2017 we created the youth camp reimbursement program in which NSSA would reimburse a club who hosted a camp and a registered shoot up to \$25 to support the camp attendee in shooting registered targets. We only had one club take advantage of this program (although a few were first timers), but I feel the way the program is setup it is restrictive. This is due to the 2-month window and the criteria that only the club that hosted the youth camp would be eligible. I have reached out to the youth shooting development committee for input on how to improve.

Marketing Videos

We budgeted for a youth marketing video in 2017 but this never got off the ground this year. The main reason for this was fear of making a poor product that would not be useful to us. Also, during 2017, we began working with MCA who we are leaning on for promotional advice and input on how we should grow our organizations. As it currently stands, this project is on hold.

Miscellaneous:

Here are a few items related to youth shooting:

The NSC hosted the San Antonio Junior Shoot Out in 2017 which is a large trap and sporting clays event with approximately 800 shooters. The NSC will host again in 2018.

The 2017 Junior World was a great success in St. Joe Indiana. This year the shoot will be held at the National Shooting Complex. We are also looking to include a sporting clays event as well for this year.

In 2017 I attended the SCTP National Championship. There were over 900 skeet shooters and over 1000 sporting clays shooters. NSSA/NSCA and SCTP work to have all the shooters who attend Nationals become members and also register the 200 targets that they shoot in each discipline.

The ACUI Collegiate Championships is also hosted at NSC.
