1. Approval of 2020 Regional Shoot Criteria Changes

The requested changes to Regional Shoot criteria for the 2020 Regional events were proposed to the EC. Richard Edie made a motion to approve the changes and Tom Sweeney seconded the motion.

2. 2021 USASCT Criteria

a. Sporting

Discussion took place regarding allowing a hybrid points race for the 2021 team selection that would include allowing events from the 2019 qualifiers to count in the 2020 points race. It was further discussed how many 2019 qualifiers to use for 2020, one or two.

A motion was made by Harvey Schwartz that qualifying for a position on the 2021 NSCA USA Sporting Clays Sporting Team will be based on points earned from a total of four events as follows. The highest of: your score from the 2020 National Championship Main Event plus three (3) scores from the 2020 Regional Main Events, or your score from the 2020 National Championship Main Event plus two (2) scores from the 2020 Regional Main Events and one (1) score from ANY of the 2019 Qualifying Main Events. With either option, participation in the 2020 National Championship Main Event is mandatory and that score will count as one (1) of the 2020 qualifier shoots. In the event of ties, your score at the 2020 National Championship will be used to break ties. Brett Seibert seconded the motion.
