These metrics and results will play a critical role in assisting the NSCA in its ongoing outreach efforts to support women shooters.

Grants will be reviewed by the NSCA Executive Council and Executive Director. If approved, grants will be awarded in amounts from \$1000-\$5000. Grants funds will be distributed by NSCA annually in the form of reimbursement upon proper submission to NSCA of receipts, documentation and cooperative marketing media, i.e., Photos, videos, and an event/program result summary
