GENERAL INFORMATION

PAYMENTS - Credit cards (VISA, American Express, Master Card, Discover), checks and cash will be accepted.

REGISTRATION - Only by using the official prepayment form or scorechaser.com will prepayment of entry fees be accepted.

Registration Office will open Monday 12 PM - 5 PM and Tuesday - Sunday 7 AM - 5 PM. Main Event entry will close at 2 PM on Thursday.

DAILY FEE - \$5 per 100 on all registered targets. (\$4 to NSCA, \$1 to TSCA)

MAINTENANCE FEE - A \$2 fee per 100 targets will be charged in all events shot. These specially designated monies will be used for maintenance and/or improvements at the National Shooting Complex.

REFUNDS - No refunds of advance deposits or prepaid entry fees after Tuesday, March 31 except for emergencies. A written request must be submitted.

All entries are final. After March 31st, except for emergencies, entry fees will not be refunded unless the event is cancelled. Shoot management will consider emergency medical withdrawals accompanied by a written request.

ELIGIBILITY - This is an International Event Open to all countries. All participants must be current members of the NSCA. Membership applications will be accepted at the shoot. US Shooters are requested to provide their social security number at the time of entry so that award checks can be sent promptly. Per IRS regulations, shooters whose cash awards total \$2,500 or more must provide their social security number before payouts can be made to the shooter.

NSCA concurrents are based on age and/or gender. Eligibility is determined by the shooter's age on the first day of the target year, and the shooter remains in that concurrent for the entire target year.

Sub-Junior: Has not reached the 16th birthday by Jan. 1 of the target year

Junior: Has not reached the 21st birthday

Veteran: 55 years or older but less than 65

Super Veteran: 65 years or older but less than 73

Sr. Super Veteran: 73 years or older but less than 80

Legacy: 80 years or older

Lady: A female of any age

RULES & REGULATIONS - All NSCA rules apply. NSCA FITASC rules apply in all FITASC Event, including those applying to age. American Field Sporting rules apply to the 50-target AFS event.

PROTESTS AND CORRECTIONS – Corrections to scores, event and concurrent entries and entry into Special Concurrents should be reported to the Registration Desk as soon as they are noticed. It is vitally important for shooters to check the scoreboard to make certain they have been entered in all events for which they are qualified as no additions or corrections to Concurrent and Special Concurrent entries will be made after 12 PM Saturday, April 25th. Shooters are urged to check their scores each day as corrections to awards will not be made unless Registration is notified prior to shoot-offs beginning or, in the case of awards not involved in ties, before 8 PM Sunday, April 26.

Protests must be submitted, in writing, to Shoot Management by 6 PM (or 15 minutes after last shot fired) the day the event is shot. Exception: Shooters needing to file a protest on an occurrence that happened on the last flight of the day must immediately report to Shoot Management for instructions. All protests must be made in accordance with NSCA, FITASC, or AFS rules and will be decided by the Protest Committee whose decision is final.

SHOOT-OFFS - All registered event shoot-offs will be held on Sunday. Shoot-off results take precedence over tiebreaker station results.

All ties in the World English Sporting Clays Main Event Championship for Open Sixth Place, Class First- Third and Concurrent Champion, Runner-Up, and Third, will be shot off Sunday evening at the conclusion of all events prior to the Super Final. Ties for all other places will be decided by total score on predetermined tiebreaker stations.

SUPER FINAL SHOOT-OFF - On Sunday evening, following the completion of all other shoot-offs, a Super Final will be held in the Stadium.

The Super Final will feature the top six (6) shooters from the Main Event. Any tie for sixth place will be resolved by a shoot-off prior to the Super Final to determine the final qualifying competitor.

Each of the six shooters will attempt 25 targets during the Super Final. The number of targets hit in the Super Final will be added to each shooter's Main Event score to determine the overall winners of the World English Sporting Clays Championship.

Example: 196 Main Event score + 23 Super Final targets = Total score of 219

In all 100-bird events, shoot-offs will be held only for Open Champion, Runner-Up and Third, Class First and Concurrent Champion. Ties for other places will be decided by total score on predetermined

tie-breaker stations.

50-bird events will not be shoot-off & all ties will be decided by total score on predetermined tiebreaker stations. If there is a tie for perfect score then the shoot-off will be announced prior to shoot-offs.

PAYMENT OF PURSES AND OPTIONS - All purse, option and other payments will be sent to shooters after the shoot. Checks for awards totaling \$2,500 or more will not be mailed until we have been provided with shooter's SSN.

RV SITES - For a camper site during this event, contact the Pro-Shop at 210-254-1526 or email at nscrvc@nssa-nasca.com. All campers must check in with the Pro-Shop upon arrival.

SHOTGUN STORAGE - Secure storage is available to shooters at a cost of \$5 per day per gun. Available starting Monday, April 20th.

TROPHIES AND PRIZES - In the Main Event trophies and medallions will be awarded to Overall, Concurrent, Class, and Team; Champion, Runner-Up, and Third. In FITASC, Super Sporting, 5-Stand, and the Prelim trophies and medallions will be awarded to Overall Champion, Runner-Up, and Third. All other award winners will receive an award package in the mail that will allow them to choose their award based on place won. Instructions on the award procedure will be included in the award package.

Unless annotated on the page listing the individual events, all events will award in:

Class: Master - AA - A - B - C - D

Concurrent: Lady - Sub-Junior - Junior - Veteran - Super Veteran - Senior Super Veteran - Legacy

PRACTICE FIELDS - The sporting clays practice course will be open Monday 9 AM - 6PM and Tuesday – Sunday 7 AM - 6 PM.

AMMUNITION - Available at various prices for different loads will be all major brands of factory ammunition. **No reloads allowed.** Maximum loads for any event (including games):

CLAYS CARS - Individually-owned clays cars, Gators, Mules and other similar vehicles are allowed or, if you prefer, clays cars may be rented. No ATVs or 4-wheelers allowed. You must be at least 18 years old to operate a clays car. Special rules apply and permits are required for both personal and rental carts. Personal cart forms can be downloaded from bit.ly/WorldEnglishSC. A \$15 trail fee is required for all personal carts. A cart permit will be issued upon NSC receiving the trail fee and verifying insurance. For more specific information, contact Stephanie Haga at shaga@nssa-nasca.com. PERSONAL CART INSURANCE - NSSA-NSCA-NSC has implemented a policy that proof of liability insurance is required for operation of personally-owned carts at the facility. Minimum liability, such as written for auto policies, for injury/accident is what is required. The policy is required to have reference to the cart that is to be operated and often can be added to current auto or home owner policies. Upon arrival, a permit, which must be displayed on the cart, will be available for pick-up in registration. If you are unable to send insurance prior to arrival, simply bring your proof of insurance to registration when you arrive and a permit will be produced and issued.

LIABILITY FOR USE OF PERSONAL OR RENTED CARTS/UTVS - Any individual who operates a personally owned or rented cart or utility task vehicle (UTV) on the premises of the National Shooting Complex shall be solely and fully responsible for any and all damages to other carts, personal property, or property belonging to the National Shooting Complex, whether caused directly or indirectly by their actions. The National Shooting Complex shall bear no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any such damages caused by participants, spectators, or third parties. By entering the premises and operating such a vehicle, the operator expressly agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the National Shooting Complex from any claims, damages, losses, or expenses arising therefrom.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/LIGHTNING PLAN OF ACTION - The National Shooting Complex (NSC) will utilize a weather monitoring and alert system to detect the presence and occurrence of lightning and other hazardous weather conditions. Shoot Management will be notified, through the alert system, of lightning and any other potential dangerous elements.

If lightning is detected within 6 miles of NSC, a cease-fire will be called immediately via PA system and any other means where PA is not available. Shooting will suspend for a period of no less than 20 minutes. All fields will be cleared of both participants and staff, with all taking cover in available areas, i.e.: Club House, Vendor Buildings, vehicles, etc. Shoot management will continue to monitor lightning strikes, via the alert system. The weather alert system will automatically track the time after each lightning strike and a new time clock will start after any strike within the 6 mile radius. After the duration of 20 minutes with no strikes within the 6 mile radius, shoot management will begin the process of returning participants to the field(s) to continue shooting. By starting this process at 20 minutes, the total elapsed time from the last strike until shooting begins is anticipated to be 30 or more minutes.

The above process will be repeated for any and all storms / lightning strikes observed. In the event of any other dangerous elements of an approaching storm, such as extremely high winds/ tornado or hail, the same cease-fire and field evacuation procedures as above will be implemented.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS- Mandatory eye and ear protection— all persons, spectators, shooters, referees and trap personnel must wear eye and ear protection on the course. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the National Shooting Complex property.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT - Any shooter exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct of any kind will be subject to disqualification. Forms of unsportsmanlike conduct include, but are not limited to; falsifying scores, badgering the referees, calling chips for yourself, begging for targets, and verbal or physical abuse of any shooter, scorer, field judge, shoot official or protest committee.

SOLICITING - No literature of any kind may be distributed on the grounds without prior approval of the NSCA.

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY - The National Sporting Clays Association and National Shooting Complex welcome you to the World English Sporting Clays Championship! This promises to be an event to remember, and much of it will be memorialized in photos and video. Because there will be photographers, videographers, social media content producers, and other members of the media at the event, we have press policies to ensure that nothing interferes with what you're here for – enjoying shooting and competing at your highest possible level. Here are a few things you should know about our expectations for the media:

- Members of the press are being asked to agree to policies that set out our expectations. They are reminded that this event is first and foremost a championship event that exists for the benefit of its participants. They are not allowed to interfere with your shooting or the event itself.
- For interviews, staged photography, or other contact with participants, members of the press are not to approach you while you are actively participating in a shooting event. Instead, they are expected to wait to approach you after you have completed the rotation or event you are competing in.
- Photographers must remain safely behind the line of the shooter and out of the shooter's field of view at all times.
- Shooters have a right to complain about any member of the press interfering with your shooting. If this occurs, first call it to the attention of the trapper/referee for an immediate remedy, then contact Sherry Kerr, Director of Communications, 205-966-0232 (text or call), skerr@nssa-nsca.com.
- The NSCA and its official publication, Clay Target Nation, will have photographers and

videographers on the property during the event. Because they are managing official photography for member publication coverage, publicity, streaming/posting to members, association archives, and other purposes, they will be given priority in covering shoot-offs, and awards presentations. Other photographers, families, and fans will have an opportunity to shoot photos, but it may not interfere with NSCA's official photography/videography.

- Unless you explicitly request otherwise, your photo may be taken at the event and potentially used in press coverage or for NSCA's marketing purposes. Unless you have an existing relationship (i.e., sponsorship or Pro Team) with a manufacturer or other company, we will not make your photos available for any commercial use without your express permission. To request not to be photographed or to appear in press coverage of the event, contact Sherry Kerr, 205-966-0232, skerr@nssa-nzca.com. Participants may not opt out of awards photos except by not posing for photos on the podium.

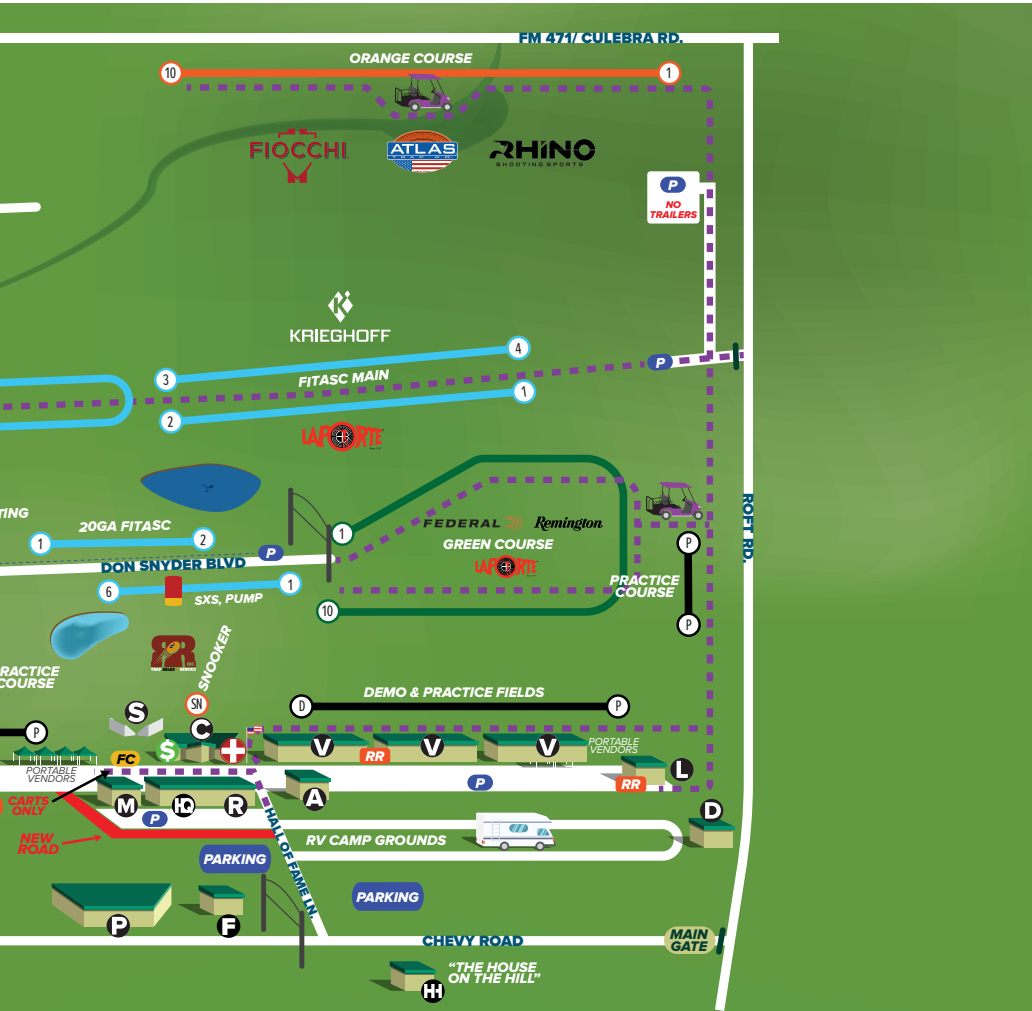

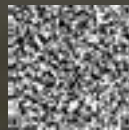

DETERMINING A WORLD CHAMPION

If the main event of the World English Championship is shortened due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of the National Shooting Complex and National Sporting Clays Association the following procedure will be used to establish the World English Sporting champion, runner up, and third place.

- 1) The total score shot from all competitors plus the addition of 66 or 68 (whichever course you have not shot) targets for the remaining course not shot will be the raw score to determine the shoot off for champion, runner-up, and third place for the World English Championship. The top 6 scores will move into the stadium field to attempt a 25 bird Super Final. The competitors will continue to shoot an additional 25 targets until all ties have been broken to establish the Champion, Runner Up, and third as well as any additional places in Master Class. Ties for sixth place will be resolved by a shoot-off prior to the Super Final to determine the final qualifying competitor. First Second and third in all classes and concurrent will be determined by a shoot off in the corresponding field to determine class and concurrent champions. No champion will be named unless all competitors have shot at least 132 target.
- 2) Ties will be shot-off or broken as if no uncontrollable occurrence has happened.
- 3) The shoot-off for champion, runner-up and third place will be held, weather permitting, on Sunday of the World English Championship in the Shoot-off Stadium at approximately 6:30 p.m. CST.
- 4) The shoot-off for first, second and third place in all Classes and Concurrents will be held, weather permitting, on Sunday of the World English Championship at approximately 6:30 p.m. CST at a site to be announced.
- 5) If these above mentioned shoot-offs cannot be held on Sunday evening prior to 10:00 p.m. CST due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of the National Shooting Complex and National Sporting Clays Association the champion, runner up, and third place as well as first, second, and third places for all Classes and Concurrents shall be decided by scores on 4 pre determined tie breaker stations on each course(s) that all competitors who are tied have completed. Assuming competitors have completed the course, the pre determined tie breaker stations will be used from courses in the following order: Green, Orange, Yellow. If there is still a tie after comparing scores on all possible tie breaker stations the Class and Concurrent champion, runner up, and third place will be determined by the longest run from the front on courses they have all completed following the order listed above.
- 6) Any shooter who is not present 10 (ten) minutes before the shoot-off shall forfeit his or her position. The position will not be filled by any alternates.
- 7) The shoot-off rotation will be determined by a lottery draw completed inside registration.
- 8) The World English Sporting Champion will be the individual with the highest score.

CONTINGENCY PLAN

PRELIM, 5-STAND, SMALL GAUGE, SUPER SPORTING, LONE STAR CUP, PARCOURS DE CHASSE, AND AMERICAN FIELD SPORTING EVENTS

If the Prelim, 5-Stand, Small Gauge, Super Sporting, Lone Star Cup or Parcours de Chasse event of the World English Championship is shortened due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of the National Shooting Complex and National Sporting Clays Association the following procedure will be used to establish the open champion, runner up, and third place as well as Class and Concurrent champions from shooters who have completed the events.

- 1) All awards will be based on scores of competitors who complete the event. If no shooters complete the event, no awards or punches will be provided.
- 2) Shoot-offs for event champion, runner up, and third place will be conducted on Sunday evening at approximately 6:30 p.m. at a site to be announced.
- 3) Shoot-offs for Concurrent and Class champion, runner up, and third place in the Prelim, 5-Stand, Super Sporting, Lone Star Cup, Small Gauge and Parcours de Chasse events will be conducted on Sunday evening at approximately 6:30 p.m. at a site to be announced.
- 4) The shoot-off will be held, weather permitting, on Sunday of the World English Championship at approximately 6:30 p.m. CST. If the shoot-off cannot be held on Sunday evening prior to 10:00 p.m. CST due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of the National Shooting Complex and National Sporting Clays Association the Prelim, 5-Stand, Super Sporting, Lone Star Cup, Small Gauge and Parcours de Chasse event's open champion, runner up, and third place as well as Class and Concurrent champions shall be decided by scores on (3) three rank ordered, pre determined tie breaker stations. If there is still a tie after comparing scores on all possible tie breaker stations the open champion, runner up, third place and Class and Concurrent champions will be determined by the longest run from the front of the event.
- 5) Any shooter who is not present 10 (ten) minutes before the shoot-off shall forfeit his or her position. The position will not be filled by any alternates.
